The series is designed to **amplify women's voices** in international affairs, deepen strategic and geopolitical literacy, and equip African women with the analytical tools necessary to influence policy, governance, peace, and security at the highest levels.

Structured into thematic Seasons, each composed of weekly debate sessions, the programme explores critical continental issues through sharp analysis, expert perspectives, and informed dialogue.

This platform empowers African women to:

- Understand and interpret global power dynamics
- Participate in high-level geopolitical dialogue
- Influence public policy and governance
- Strengthen Africa's voice in international decision-making

Building on the momentum of the successful G20 Series, the December edition marks the official launch of Season 1 of the Women in Geopolitics Programme.

SEASON 1 THEME (DEC 2025 – MAR 2026) : “THE AFRICAN UNION AT A CROSSROADS: POWER, REFORM & AFRICA’S GLOBAL FUTURE”

This season examines the African Union's institutional strengths, governance challenges, diplomatic presence, and future role in global power dynamics.

Speakers are invited from across Africa's diplomatic, governance, academic, and thought-leadership communities.
